Dear Anita's Family, Friends and Students,

With deep regret we received this very sad information, that our Friend and Colleague Anita Köhler has passed away untimely.

Anita was Co-founder of ISBA and Board Member for 8 consecutive years. She was always among creators, organizers and participant of meaningful activities: GERK Self-Study Group of European Instructors on Kashimano Tachi (2011-2014), International Summer Seminars in Darmstadt (2009) and Strausberg (2012), Budo Spirit Research Seminars with Inaba Sensei (2013-2015), Youth Exchange between Japanese and German Kids (2014, 2016), Women Group Visit to Shiseikan in 2015. In May 2017 she accomplished her long-term dream: Himorogi Budojo. Unfortunately, due to health heavy condition, Anita was unable to attend its inauguration.

In August 2017 we started to discuss with Anita plans to celebrate 10th Anniversary of ISBA, aimed for 27th of April 2019. We chose Bad Saarow as a place, and Anita was happy to host us at Himorogi Budojo. We want to keep up the wish of Anita, and, if circumstances permit, look forward meeting there in Spring next year, believing that Anita's spirit will be with us.

Within last 2 weeks ISBA Board received many letters from Europe and Japan with commemorative testimonies. Let us quote some of them:
